Meridian Balancing Combinations

Over 5,000 years ago, the ancient Chinese discovered an entire system of subtle energy in the body that is only now able to be "read" by our modern diagnostic and imaging tools. Energy disturbances in these subtle systems precede the manifestation of abnormal patterns of cellular organization and growth.

There is a primary energetic substance of which everything in the universe is composed. Physical matter and energy are two different manifestations of this primary substance. Matter, which vibrates at a very slow frequency, relatively speaking, is referred to as physical matter. That which vibrates at speeds exceeding the velocity of light is know as subtle matter. Subtle matter is just as real as the more dense form of matter.

The Chinese have mapped out for us twelve meridians, or pathways, along which this energy travels in the human body. These meridians were named for the life function associated with them. To the majority of scientists in the western hemisphere, these meridians seem like imaginary structures because there are no published anatomical studies of them in orthodox medical journals to substantiate their existence. The medical community does admit, however, that there is much about "energy" in the human body that cannot be explained in terms of circulation, nerves, or by the electrical impulses that they can trace.

Meridians are the pathways of communication between the various parts of the human body/mind/ soul complex. Through these meridians pass an invisible nutritive energy known to the Chinese as ch'i. The ch'i energy enters the body through specific points and flows to deeper organ structures, bringing life-giving nourishment of a subtle energetic nature.

The meridians, and specific acupuncture points along them, have been mapped by modern technological methods—electronically, thematically, and radioactively. Normal energy over one of these points, when healthy and vibrant, is approximately 100,000 ohms. With practice and awareness this energy can be felt and located by the human hand, with micro-electrical voltage meters, and with muscle testing. It is often easier to feel a point with your hand when the point is not functioning correctly.

A strong and balanced flow of energy through the body's meridians is important to optimal health. Blocked meridians create imbalanced energy flow to organs which contributes to disease states within the body. There are emotional and mental characteristics associated with each pair of meridians. In fact, some of what we call personality is dictated by the way the energy is flowing through our meridians.

Energy flow through the meridians can be slowed or entirely blocked by a number of factors, including traumatic injury, emotional trauma, chronic illnesses, parasite infestations, and chemical toxicity. Impaired flow in a meridian is often responsible for slow healing of wounds and injuries, as well as slow response to herbal, chiropractic, or homeopathic treatment.

The idea of using a homeopathic combination to improve flow along a meridian is a good one. There is one homeopathic combination for each meridian listed on the next few pages. The basic symptom picture of each single remedy within the combination is explained separately (as it has been on all the previous pages for the other combinations). This will enable you to choose for yourself whether to take a low-potency combination remedy, or zero in on a particular remedy contained in the blend and take just that one in a higher potency.

A very brief description of the emotional pattern of each meridian is given. You should be able to draw a fairly accurate picture of the meridian's out-of-balance state by the descriptions of the single remedies.

Governing Vessel Balance (6X)

Moving forward on life's path with faith and confidence or

Embarrassment, reluctance to move forward at all

Homeopathic ingredients: Arsenicum album (white oxide of arsenic) Aurum metallicum (gold metal), Baryta carbonica (barium carbonate), Cactus grandiflorus (night-blooming cereus), Calcarea carbonica (calcium carbonate), Lithium carbonicum (lithium carbonate), Lycopodium clavatum (club moss), Mercurius solublis (mercury vivus), Natrum sulphuricum (sodium sulfate), Spigelia anthelmintica (pinkroot), Tarentula hispanica (Spanish tarentula)

Arsenicum album Constricted air passages. Hay fever. Suffocative catarrh. Wheezy breathing. Asthma. Shortness of breath. Cough alternating between dry and loose. Cough excited by smoking. Emphysema. Cough with bloody sputum and pulmonary edema.

Aurum metallicum High blood pressure. Pulse rapid. Feeble. Irregular. Angina pectoris.

Baryta carbonica Crawling in rectum. Constipation with hard knotty stools. Hemorrhoids protrude on urinating. Oozing at anus. Diarrhea with lumbar ache.

Cactus grandiflorus Constriction as from an iron band. Very acute pains and stitches in heart. Pulse feeble and irregular. Endocarditis with mitral valve insufficiency together with violent and rapid action. Murmurs. Low blood pressure. Aneurysm of large arteries and heart. Arteriosclerosis.

Calcarea carbonica Sharp pain in chest, which is very sensitive to touch, percussion or pressure.

Lithium carbonicum Trembling and fluttering of heart. Throbbing and dull stitch in cardiac region.

Lycopodium clavatum Indigestion with pain and distress in gastric region. Nausea with faintness. Gastritis. Enteritis. Diarrhea. Dysentery.

Mercurius solublis Palpitations on slightest exertion. Worse for any change in temperature or weather. Restlessness. Poor self-confidence. Chronic ear infections. Trembling limbs—especially the hands. Shortness of breath walking upstairs. Burning after urination. Urine flows in thin stream or only drop by drop.

Natrum suphuricum Particularly indicated after head injury. Pain through lower left chest. Gallbladder disorders. Headache. All symptoms worse for cold and damp. Painful cramps with flatulence.

Spigelia anthelmintica Pericarditis. Angina pectoris.

Tarentula hispanica Twitching. Involuntary movements. Restlessness of lower limbs. Constipation. Stool remains in rectum for a long time with no urging.

Central Vessel Balance (6X)

- Lachesis muta Dry cough. Bloody urine. Pulse weak, slow, and irregular. Headache.
- Mercurius solublis Worse for any change in temperature or weather. Restlessness. Poor selfconfidence. Chronic ear infections. Trembling limbs—especially the hands. Shortness of breath walking upstairs. Burning after urination. Urine flows in thin stream or only drop by drop.
- Pulsatilla nigricans Changeable mood. Mild temperament. Emotional and tearful. Consolation improves all symptoms. Pain goes to part lain on. Vaginal discharge that is milky or with burning. Inflammation in womb.
- Sepia succus Venous stasis. Hormonal disorders. Bladder weak. Bed-wetting. Oversensitive to noise. Poor circulation. Restlessness in limbs. Liver sore and painful. Frequent flushes of heat. Arsenicum album Great polycrest remedy suitable to many people for many things. Sudden very great weakness. Liver and spleen enlarged and painful. Vomiting with diarrhea. Intense thirst. Palpitations with anguish which are worse at night. Inflammation from food or chemical poisoning. Great weakness. Vomiting and diarrhea.

Belladonna Loss of appetite. Vision difficulties. Nausea and Vomiting. Ear pain. Tinnitus.

Calcarea carbonica Food cravings. Gallstones. Colic. Susceptible to cold.

Carduus marianus Gallbladder swollen and painful. Liver and spleen disorders. Varicose veins. Edema. Headaches.

Colocynthis Sudden horrible cramping with tearing pains. Greatly affected by the misfortunes of others. Neuralgia with chilliness.

Lycopodium clavatum Weak memory. Dyslexia. Indecision. Poor self-esteem. Panic attacks. Involuntary urination. Poor digestion. Loss of appetite. Hypoglycemia. Diabetes. Desire for sweets. Food allergies—often to wheat.

Anxious restlessness and fidgety. Constantly busy. Better for cool air but worse from heat of any kind. Allergic dermatitis. Thirstless during fever.
- **Berberis vulgaris** Inflammation of the kidneys. Bladder disorders. Gallstones. Kidney stones with severe pain. Pimples with dry rough scaly skin.

- **Argentum nitricum** Impulsive. Wants to do things in a hurry. Melancholy. Panic attacks. Performance anxiety. Irresistible desire for sugar and sweets. Colic with much gas and distention. Acute conjunctivitis. Hypoglycemia. Great craving for sweets which disagree. Emotional upsets bring on migraines or diarrhea. Bloody urine and fever.

- Mercuris solubilis Worse for any change in temperature or weather. Restlessness. Poor selfconfidence. Chronic ear infections. Trembling limbs—especially the hands. Shortness of breath walking upstairs. Burning after urination. Urine flows in thin stream or only drop by drop.
- **Rhus toxicodendron** Stiffness of muscles and joints that is better for warmth, motion, or massage. Glands are swollen. Weeping without knowing the cause. Back strain or injury. Sciatica, Incontinence. Restless tossing about in sleep. Intense itching of the skin.
- Terebinthiniae oleum Inflammation of kidneys. Burning pain in region of kidneys. Bloody urine with odor of violets. Enormous distension of the abdomen. Fever with violent thirst. Profuse, cold, clammy sweat, especially on the legs.

Large Intestine Meridian Balance (6X) Confidence, feeling of self-worth

Guilt, low self-esteem, discouragement

- Homeopathic ingredients: Aloe socotrina (common aloes), Aluminum oxydata (aluminun oxide), Arsenicum album (white oxide of arsenic), Baryta carbonica (barium carbonate), Bryonia alba (wild hops), Carbo vegetabilis (vegetable charcoal), Plumbum metallicum (lead metal), Pyrogenium (rotten meat pus)
- **Aloe socotrina** Dissatisfied and angry about himself. Sadness in morning. Better evening. Abdominal pains better from passing burning offensive flatus. Abdomen feels hot, heavy and bloated. Headaches that are worse from heat but better with cold application. Hemorrhoids bleed often and profusely.
- **Aluminum oxydata** Alternating moods. Hasty and hurried. Confusion as to personal identity. Severe constipation. Colic. Abdominal pain. Potatoes disagree with the digestion. Legs often feel prickly and asleep.
- **Arsenicum album** Great polycrest remedy suitable to many people for many things. Sudden very great weakness. Liver and spleen enlarged and painful. Vomiting with diarrhea. Intense thirst. Palpitations with anguish which are worse at night.
- **Baryta carbonica** Takes cold easily. Enlargement of the glands. Always has swollen tonsils. Slow mental grasp. Habitual colic of children who do not thrive.
- **Bryonia alba** Bursting, splitting headaches. Aggravation from movement of any kind. Exceeding irritability. Sharp pains and stiffness in back. Slipped disks with sharp pain. Dry hacking cough. Pleurisy with sharp pains. Dryness of mouth, tongue, and throat with excessive thirst. Symptoms of inflammation of the liver.
- **Carbo vegetabilis** Sick and exhausted. Faints easily. Lack of reaction following violent shock. Persons who have never fully recovered from some previous illness. Abdomen greatly distended. Flatulent colic. Constipation. Pains extending to chest with distention of abdomen. Almost all foods cause distress. Icy coldness.
- **Plumbum metallicum** Mental depression. Navel feels retracted and tense. Chronic nephritis. Failure to thrive in infants. Glaucoma which originates in a spinal disorder. Face is pale and emaciated. Distinct blue lines along margins of gums.
- **Pyrogenium** Offensive carrion-like discharges. Diarrhea with fever. Small cuts or injuries become infected and inflamed. Sleeplessness. Bed feels too hard. Abdomen bloated. Constipation. Any septic condition.

Homeopathic ingredients: Apis mellifica (honey bee), Arsenicum album (white oxide of arsenic), Carbo vegetabilis (vegetable charcoal), Chamomilla vulgaris (German chamomile), Kali bichromicum (potassium bichromate), Phosphorus, Sulphur (brimstone)

Apis mellifica Breathing with panting. Edema and swelling of larynx. Feelings of suffocation. Short dry breathing. Burning and soreness when urinating. Frequent and involuntary urination. Difficult or slow urination. Swelling or puffing up of various parts. Edema. Anxious restlessness and fidgetiness. Constantly busy. Better for cool air but worse from heat of any kind. Allergic dermatitis. Thirstless during fever.

Arsenicum album Great polycrest remedy suitable to many people for many things. Constricted air passages. Hay fever. Wheezing. Asthma. Pulmonary edema. Sudden very great weakness. Liver and spleen enlarged and painful. Vomiting with diarrhea. Intense thirst. Palpitations with anguish which are worse at night.

Carbo vegetabilis Breathing laborious, quick, and short. Cough with itching of larynx. Spasmodic with gagging and vomiting of mucous. Burning in chest. Hemorrhage from lungs. Sick and exhausted. Faints easily. Lack of reaction following violent shock. Persons who have never fully recovered from some previous illness.

Chamomilla vulgaris Temperamental and oversensitive persons. Children demand and seem to be better for being carried. Demands instant relief from suffering. Tickling cough, hoarseness.

Kali bichromicum Asthma. Dry cough. Profuse yellow expectoration. Cough with pain in sternum. Headaches over eyebrows. Sinus headache with stopped-up sensation in nose. Pressure and pain at root or bridge of nose. Blindness before headache. Very weak limbs. Pains migrate from place to place. Great sadness that is better after eating. Impatient. Talks to himself.

Phosphorus Oppressive breathing. Congestion of lungs. Pneumonia of left lower lung. Asthma with congestion. Ravenous hunger during fever. Excitable. Impressionable. Tightness across chest. Pain and burning in stomach. Vomiting. Very fetid stools and flatus. Tendency to get sore throats that go into the lungs.

Sulphur Absent-minded. Indifferent to personal appearance. Pneumonia. Loose cough. Tickling in larynx. Asthma. Difficult respiration. Wants window open. "Ragged philosophers". Ailments and complaints that relapse. Sulphur should be considered when carefully chosen, well-matched homeopathic remedy fails to act, especially in acute diseases. Major anti-psoric remedy. Frequently needed when an illness has mostly cleared up, but still lingers.

Stomach Meridian Balance (6X)

Contentment, appreciation for what is in one's life

or

Disappointment, greed, attitude of "there is never enough"

- Homeopathic ingredients: Arsenicum album (white oxide of arsenic), Calcarea carbonica (calcium carbonate), Digitalis purpurea (foxglove), Ignatia amara (St. Ignatius bean), Lycopodium clavatum (club moss), Phosphorus (the element), Pulsatilla nigricans (wind flower), Veratrum viride(American hellebore)
- **Arsenicum album** Great polycrest remedy suitable to many people for many things. Sudden very great weakness. Liver and spleen enlarged and painful. Vomiting with diarrhea. Heartburn. Intense thirst. Palpitations with anguish which are worse at night.
- **Calcarea carbonica** Food cravings. Gallstones. Colic. Heartburn. Belching. Cramps. Susceptible to cold and made worse by it.
- **Digitalis purpurea** Cardio-pulmonary remedy. Great weakness. Liver becomes enlarged and painful. Shortness of breath. Neuralgic pain in stomach. Excessive nausea, not better for vomiting. Heartburn. Great guilt, but feels better for crying. Weeping improves nearly all symptoms. Anxiety about the future. Deep sighing and grief. Great weakness will illness. So weak can barely communicate.
- **Ignatia amara** An emotional state of grief and worry. Suppressed grief or longing. Hiccups. Belching. Cramps. Flatulence—especially at night. Distention of abdomen causes inability to breathe.

Intense thirst but cold water causes distress followed by vomiting. Inflammation from food or chemical poisoning. Great weakness.

Belladonna Loss of appetite. Vision difficulties. Nausea and vomiting. Distended abdomen. Colic. Pain in spleen region. Ear pain. Tinnitus. Symptoms come on suddenly and violently. Hot, red skin. Flushed face. Dilated pupils. Throbbing carotids. Sensitive to light, noise, and jarring. Very restless. Retention of urine in bladder.

Cinchona/China officinalis Liver and spleen swollen and enlarged. Digestion weak and slow. Dysentery with dehydration and weakness. Intolerable pain in lumbar region. Aurum metallicum High blood pressure. Pulse rapid. Feeble. Irregular heartbeat. Angina pectoris. Aurum depression is the most acute of any remedy. Melancholy. Hopelessness. Deep grief. Depression, along with other Aurum symptoms is always cause for concern because there is a great desire to commit suicide. Suicide is seen as the only way out and the only way to end the pain.
